ASTROLOGICAL STUDY OF KARMIC SIGNIFICATORS OF POLICE PROFESSIONAL

ABSTRACT

If one seeks to find out what one's specific karma is, then that time may be in fact be wasted, for in the duration, the individual would have been living out his karma anyway. The point is that the part of the profession is not being a specific bhava/planet, rather it is a blend of the supporting factors as well. For a native to be a Police officer, involvement of Mars and Saturn is important. The Sun must also support the Lagna to 10th Bhava. The involvement of fiery signs such as Aries, Leo or Sagittarius with the 10th, 2nd or 11th Lord is also a strong indicator.

INTRODUCTION

According to the karma of the previous life, everyone is born. Discharging his duties at the right place and right time will only lead to reduce his karmic debt, a native with a particular profession is predestined to discharge his karmic duties in the chosen path. Karma in Sanskrit means Action, in present age, the kind of action undertaken by a native is decided by his profession. Karma, we hold is the one aspect which decides the quality of life, position, status in the society, power, influence, kindness, character, speech, wealth, education, property, heir, disease, litigation, enemies, debts, spouse, disaster, accidents, fortune, desires, success, travel, likewise each and every aspect of the native.

In the present phenomenon, when karma is researched for, it narrows down to profession,

indicated by 10th bhavas. Each and every person spends majority of his time in pursuit of his profession so that all other aspects of his life gets fulfilled. One cannot escape his duties in the society. It is clearly understood that everyone seeks for a happy, successful, profitable career. Our day-to-day routine revolves around the career. Hence the 10thBhava is rightly called as Karma Bhava. Not everyone is successful in career. Some go astray by choosing a wrong career path Career is the foremost priority. In this article, we are going to highlight some of the key factors of natives who discharge their karma as a Police.

Karma as Police Professional

In natal chart, Lagna or the First Bhava plays a vital role. It gives a general impression on the native's potential. Lagna indicates the native's own efforts, his ambitions, the nature and the achievability of his ambitions. Thus Lagna can be viewed as a measure of success. A strong First bhava makes the entire horoscope capable, strong, fortunate, successful and purposeful life.

The Tenth Bhava, also called the Karma Bhava is the Bhava of profession. A strong 10thBhava improves the probability of one enjoying the correct occupation. The Lord of the Tenth Bhava gives a lead in the right direction in the prediction of profession. It also leads the quest to identify the right option across categories and sub-categories of occupation.

The position of the 10th lord throws light over the matter and further directs and guides the search. The nature and the strength of the planets, which occupy the 10th Bhava are also important and should be thoroughly studied.

Unlike other professions, Police service is a very responsible profession in the society. Police professionals are responsible in protecting the country, countrymen and maintenance of law and order. Patriotism is a key ingredient required for this profession. This is a profession that prevents citizens from breaking the rules of law. All these aspects are covered by Mars and Jupiter. Law, patriotism and feeling of responsibility towards the nation and the protection come under the influence of Jupiter. The role of police is indicated by Mars while Saturn and

Mars are responsible for most of the crimes. Therefore both these two planets are adversely but strongly placed in the birth charts of criminals like murderers, kidnappers, dacoits and smugglers. Prevention of crime and enforcement of law and punishment is the kaaragathva of Mars.

If Mars occupies the 10th bhava, the native will be proficient in the acts, be valorous, unconquerable, will serve important people, be endowed with sons and happiness and be very courageous.

Mars and Jupiter play important role in determining the occupation of police service, but the role of Saturn cannot be overlooked. The joint influence of Mars, Jupiter and Saturn over the concerning Bhavas of profession will lead the native to go to the police department.

The 6th Bhava indicates law and litigation, enmity, crime and fight etc, in addition to diseases, debts, destruction and the like. Therefore, the 6th Bhava does play a vital role in the judgment of career in police.

The 2nd and 11th Bhavas are referred for wealth and income. These Bhavas also have a lot to do in the judgment of source of income. It will not be out of place to mention that mostly the 10th Bhava is considered for all types of professions. It is decided generally by the planets placed in the 10th Bhava, the lord of the 10th Bhava and the navamsa occupied by the 10th Bhava lord, in addition to the planets having as aspect over the 10th Bhava or its lord and the planets associated with these.

As already specified, the role of the ascendant is most important as it indicates the aptitude of the native. Undertaking a profession that is in line with one's own aptitude and inclination is key to success. Hence the lagna or ascendant plays a key role in the profession.

If Mars and Jupiter conjoined in Leo ascendant, in addition to other factors of 10th Bhava, one will become a very famous, successful, popular, strict and tough Police officer.

The role of Saturn cannot be underestimated as citizens and public are the karagathva of Saturn.

Saturn indicates masses and public in general. It also indicates government service. Police has an important part to play on behalf of Government for maintaining peace and harmony of the country.

Thus, the 2nd and the 11th Bhavas, in addition to the 10th Bhava, should be under the influence of Mars, Jupiter and Saturn, either by occupation or by ownership of sign or navamsa or aspect. The 6th Bhava must be related to either of these Bhavas, in one or the other way.

Fiery signs also play an important role. If the lords of 10th, 2nd and 11th are placed in the sign or navamsa of Aries, Leo or Sagittarius, police services are strongly indicated, provided lords of concerning Bhavas are Mars, Jupiter or Saturn or the Lords of these Bhavas join the signs ruled by the significators Mars, Jupiter and Saturn. Scorpio is not a fiery sign but is an owner of fiery and Karaka planet, So Scorpio should also be taken into consideration, in additions to fiery signs.

The sun is a supporting Karaka of police services as it represents government and police department is directly under the control of government and is endowed with the authority and power rendered by the government.

Atmakaraka planet should also be taken into account. The Bhava owned by the Atmakaraka planet, and the nakshatra lord in which Atmakaraka planets falls, are of immense importance, Atmakaraka planet should always be given due importance to ascertain one's Karma.

For administrative and civil services, examination of the sixth and eighth Bhava is also essential in addition to the tenth and ninth. Luminaries and Karmic Control Planets do have a concern with the concerning Bhavas in the birth charts of those, who will be successful in the competition of civil services etc.

For civil and administrative services, eighth, ninth and tenth Bhavas should be examined properly. If there is mutual exchange of ninth and tenth lords, one becomes successful in civil services provided one of the luminaries has an influence over any of these Bhavas.

Summarizing the details above, following factors can be used by an astrologer as guidance in ascertaining a native's profession into Police Service.

Native's ascendant and Chandra lagnawill decide the native's physical and mental strength, aptitude, inclination, outlook and ambition.

The Karma Bhava will decide the Professional aspects of the native.

The 2nd Bhava will decide the source of Income of the native.

The 11th Bhava will indicate the Livelihood of the native.

The 6th Bhava indicates the native's association with litigation, crime, conflict, accidents. Thefts deceits, debts, loans, services, promotions, demotions, suspensions, examinations etc.

Mars, Jupiter and Saturn are main significators of the Police profession.

The Sun is the supporting significator of Police profession.

Aries, Leo, Scorpio and Sagittarius are the concerned signs of Rashi and navamsa

Kartika, Mrigasira, Punarvasu, Poosam, Uttaraphalguni, Chitra, Visaka, Anuradha, Uttrasadha, Dhanishtha, Poorvabhadrapad are the concerning star for Police profession.

The involvement of the Sun and the Moon in Lagna and 6^{th} Bhava or Lagna and KarmaBhava

Consideration of all above factors should be made sincerely and systematically, one by one, before finally reaching to any conclusion regard to police services.

Following are a few horoscopes of real-time Police professionals

Example No.1

The First Indian female IPS Ms. Kiran Bedi is known for her courageous, bold, most dynamic, and dashing personality. India is certainly proud of having Ms. Kiran Bedi as Director General of Police. Her daring acts established innumerable outstanding examples of honesty and fearlessness.

In Kiran Bedi's Horoscope the Venus occupies the 10^{th} Bhava, which is Gemini. The first significator of profession is Venus and the second is the lord of the 10^{th} Bhava, Mercury. In her birth chart any planet occupies the constellation of Venus? there is no such

planet. Then examine the navamsa occupied by the 10^{th} lord Mercury, and the navamsa of the planet place in the 10^{th} Bhavai.e Venus. Venus is present in Sagittarius navamsa. Mercury is present in Gemini, its own navamsa. This shows that the professions of the native may be connected with art, acting, dancing, signing or script writing.

Examining the Atmakaraka planet, which is the Sun in this case. The Sun posited in the 9th Bhava in Taurus, in Mrigsira ruled by Mars, i.e. the Sun falls in Mars constellation Mrigsira. The Sun and Mars are the strongest planets in this natal chart. The Sun obtains 1.87 Shadbalas and acquire own navamsa. This shows success in administrative field i.e Indian Police Service. Exchange of the 9th lord, Venus and 10th lord Mercury confirms Civil and administrative services. Mars and Sun are associated with the 10th lord, Mercury in the 9thBhava and further suggest success in police service.

The third step into this analysis is the 2nd Bhava, which is owned by Venus in this case, who falls in the 10thBhava, Venus obtains navamsa of Jupiter and falls in Rahu's constellation Ardra. Rahu is tenanted in Aries ruled by Mars and obtains Vargotama in navamsa. It means that Venus is under the effects of Mercury, Jupiter, Rahu and Mars and that shows that the professions tends towards engineering or Police. There after the 11th bhava should be analyzed. The lord of the 11th, Moon falls in Scorpio, rules by Mars. Moon falls in the constellation Anuradaha, rules by Saturn and obtains navamsa of the Sun. This shows police services of high level.

Finally the judgment of the 9th Bhava should be made. In this birth chart the 9th Bhava is occupied by Mercury, Mars and the Sun, which indicate police service and administration. There is mutual exchange of constellations between Mars and Sun. The Sun falls in Mrigshira and Mars fall in Karthika, whereas Mercury falls in Rohini, whose ruler Moon occupies Scorpio. This also signifies Police service of administrative level like IPS. Mars is present in Saturn's navamsa, the Sun is present in its own navamsa and Mercury is present in Gemini navamsa. The lord of 9th Bhava, Venus, falls in the 10th Bhava and obtain navamsa of Jupiter and falls in Ardra constellation.

Thus, the Mar, Sun, Jupiter, Mercury and Venus have a major role with the occupation of the native. Based on Shadbala, the order of the stronger planets is Sun > Venus > Mars > Jupiter > Mercury > Moon > Saturn.

Though Mercury is the 10th Lord, it is weak comparatively and hence it can be eliminated. Now the Mars, Sun, Venus and Jupiter will be the deciding factors of the occupation of the native. For administrative services, Sun, Venus and Moon are the significators. In this horoscope, the Sun occupies the 9th Bhava, Venus occupies the 10th Bhava; and the Moon aspects the Sun and 10th lord Mercury. Also, mutual exchange of the 9th Bhava lord Venus and the 3rd Bhava lord Mercury gives rise Mahayoga or Maharaja Yoga. This Yoga is one of the strongest planetary combinations for administrative services. Overall, the horoscope strongly indicates Class-I administrative services.

In this horoscope, the Sun, Mars and Jupiter, who are inter-related with each other as explained above. This strongly signifies Police profession. Now consider both i.e. administrative services and police services. Then, it is very clear that the native will be a successful, famous and strong IPS officer.

Example No.2

K.P.S. Gill was Inspector General of Police. He was appointed Election Commissioner after retirement. He was born in Aries ascendant, and it obtains navamsa of Mercury. Lord of the ascendant Mars is posited in the 6thBhava and aspects the ascendant. In fact, the 6th Bhava rules over crimes. It is Police's duty to prevent crime. Therefore, the 6th Bhava plays a prominent role in the birth charts of police personals. Besides this, the 6th Bhava rules over the means of livelihood through service. Involvement of the luminaries with the ascendant or the 10th Bhava or their lords, in Rashi or Navamsa or asterisms, will result into government service. Here, the lord of the ascendant, Mars, occupies the 6th Bhava itself and falls in Moon's (which is a Luminary) constellation Hasta, which justifies government police service.

The lord of the 3rd and the 6th Bhava, Mercury, occupies the 9th Bhava, which is Sagittarius sign. Jupiter, Mars and Saturn are the major significators of police services. The Sun is a supporting Karaka of

police personnel. Here, the lord of the 6th Bhava, Mercury, is associated with the Sun and Venus in the 9th Bhava. The 6th Bhava lord is Mercury and it is present in Navamsa of Cancer, which belongs to Moon. The association of Luminary once again confirms government job.

Venus is Atmakaraka planet in this horoscope. Venus rules the 2nd and the 7th Bhava and occupies the 9th Bhava in Sagittarius. Venus is present in Mars navamsa. The ascendant lord Mars is present in Venus navamsa. Thus, there is mutual exchange of navamsa between Mars and Venus, which justifies class one Government service of police i.e. I.P.S.,

In this horoscope, based on Shadbala the Sun and Saturn are the strongest planets. We have mentioned earlier that the second Bhava I should also be examined for the judgement of one's occupation. The second Bhava is owned by Venus in this birth chart, occupies the 9th Bhava Sagittarius and obtains navamsa of Mars. This shows that the native will be very successful and strong police person. Venus and Jupiter exchanges Bhava which is an exchange between a Kendra and Kona Bhavas. The lord of the Bhava Saturn stays in own sign 10th Aquarius in the Bhava. Saturn falls in Dhanishtha 11thconstellation ruled by Mars and obtains the navamsa of its exaltation. Saturn is the second strongest planet and obtains 1.44 Shadabalas and lends aspect over the and the 8thBhava apart from the ascendant. The ascendant is, therefore, aspected by its lord Mars and the 10thlord Saturn. Thus, the ascendant is very strong and is under the powerful influence of Mars and Saturn, the Karakas of police services.

The Atmakaraka and the 2nd lord Venus obtains Navamsa of Mars and falls in the sign of Jupiter corresponding with mutual exchange between Venus and Jupiter. Thus I.P.S. services are distinctly justified. The analysis may be made as given under Table No.1.

We find that Venus, Jupiter, Mars and Saturn play prominent role in the judgement of the profession and this indicates class one police service.

If Venus has also a concern with the professional aspect of the native, in addition to Mars, Jupiter and Saturn, one will be an IPS officer. In fact, Venus is the karaka of administrative or civil services,

whereas Mars, Jupiter and Saturn signify police services. Mars indicates punishment for crime control over criminals, apart from looking after the rules and regulations regarding law and order, and authority. Jupiter signifies security, safety, protection of the countrymen. Jupiter also provides help assistance and benefits of the public. Jupiter rules over the welfare of all kinds. Saturn too is a karaka as it governs prosecution, punishment, rules, law and discipline etc.

The 6th Bhava, the ascendant and the 10th Bhava should be examined along with the 2nd, 11th and 9th Bhavas and their lords. Atmakaraka planet and strongest planet prominently helps in the judgement of one's occupation.

We may hasten to add that the involvement of fiery signs Aries, Leo and Sagittarius should also be taken into consideration, in addition to Scorpio as it is ruled by the significator and the fiery planet Mars. In this birth chart, the Sun, Mercury and Venus fall in fiery signs and further justify police services of the native.

Example No.3

The native retired as Director General of Police. Lastly, the enquiry of Madhumita murder case was made under him. He was born in Taurus ascendant with Mars and Saturn, therein. The ascendant must be examined, as it indicates aptitude inclination and outlook of the native. Presence of both the significators, Mars and Saturn, shows the tendency and ambition of going into police. The ascendant obtains navamsa of Jupiter, which does play a prominent role in the birth charts of police men as it covers protection, safety, security, help and rules of law as well.

Lord of the 10th BhavaYogakaraka Saturn falls in the ascendant, identical to Mrigsira constellation, ruled by Mars. Saturn is closely associated with Mars in the ascendant and aspects the lagna lord Venus, the 3rdBhava, the lord of the ascendant and the 6thVenus, which is tenanted in the 7thBhava in the sign of Mars, in Scorpio.

The 6^{th} Bhava governs crimes, criminals, conflicts, thefts, loans, debts, diseases, accidents, fights and service matters. Therefore, the involvement of the 6^{th} Bhava, if found prominent and strong, in addition to

positive role of Mars, Saturn and Jupiter, one joins police services. In this birth chart, the lord of the 6th Bhava, Venus, occupies sign of Mars, i.e. Scorpio and is aspected by Mars and Saturn, both significators, which is a strong indication of the position of a high and successful police personnel.

The 3rd lord Moon and 11th lord Jupiter are very well associated in the 4th Bhava in Leo, and aspect the 10thBhava.

Both, Moon and Jupiter, present in navamsa of Mars, in association with Mars as well. Thus, the Bhava is 10^{th} aspected by its own lord Saturn, Jupiter and Moon. The lord of the ascendant and 6^{th} Bhava, Venus, and the Sun obtain navamsa of the significator Jupiter, where the Sun falls under vargottama navamsa.

The Sun is Atmakaraka planet in this birth chart, which falls in a fiery Jupiter's sign Sagittarius under vargottama navamsa and joins its own constellation Uttarashadha. The Sun is a primary planet that supports Class One Police Service, such as IPS.

Involvement of fiery signs, identical to the concerning planets and Bhavas, also has a significant role. Hence Scorpio is also considered, because its owner is the fiery planet Mars. Thus, Aries, Leo, Scorpio and Sagittarius signs, if influence Mars, Sun, Jupiter and Saturn in addition to the lords of the ascendant, the 6th and the 10th Bhava, one will do very well and shine in the police department.

In the horoscope, the 10th Bhava lord Saturn and the 6th Bhava lord Venus have a mutual aspect. Mars falls in Rohini, the Moon's constellation and aspects the ascendant and the 6th Bhava lord Venus. This shows government service.

Five planets viz. Moon, Mars, Jupiter, Venus and the Sun are present in navamsa of fiery signs i.e Aries and Sagittarius. Four planets viz. 3rd lord Moon, the 4th lord Sun, 3rd and 5th lord Mercury, 8th and 11th lord Jupiter, are posited in fiery signs. The strongest planet, ascendant and the 6th bhava lord Venus, falls in the sign Scorpio, ruled by the fiery significator Mars and is aspected by Mars and Saturn both, and obtains fiery navamsa Sagittarius. This strongly indicates fame and honour as an I.P.S. officer. Due to the strong planetary set up in his birth chart, the native was bound to do government service.

Example No.4

The Horoscope belongs to a person, who retired as Director General of Police. He was awarded multiple times for his brave and courageous actions.

He was born in Gemini ascendant. The ascendant obtains vargottama navamsa. Following factors are noted in the horoscope of the native:

The 8th Bhava and 9th Bhava lord Saturn, who joins the ascendant aspects the 10th Bhava and the lord Jupiter, whereas 10th lord Jupiter aspects the 9th Bhava. This indicates service in respectable and dignified class.

The 6th Bhava lord Mars falls in Leo. It is also in association with 10th Bhava lord Jupiter. Mars aspects the 6th, 9th and 10th Bhavas.

The above points strongly indicates police services. Mercury, The Ascendant lord, 7th and 10th lord Jupiter, 6th and 11th lord Mars are associated in fiery signs Leo and all of these aspect the 9thBhava.

Moon, the 2ndlord Moon is present in navamsa of Mars. The 6thBhava lord Mars is present in the navamsa of Sun, while the 9th lord and significator Saturn obtains own navamsa.

Atmakaraka planet is Venus. Itoccupies Cancer in the nakshatra of ascendant lord and also obtains fiery navamsa of Jupiter i.e. Sagittarius. This strongly indicates that the native would enter into police services of class one cadre i.e. I.P.S. Ascendant lord Mercury falls in Leo in 3rdBhava and obtains navamsa of Mars.

Thus, the ascendant, the 6th and the 10th Bhava are under the influence of the Sun, Saturn, Mars and Jupiter. These signify I.P.S. services, as explained above.
