The 'Twelve Bhavas' of a pros are calculated based on the 'Time' and Place of Birth' of a Child. We can analyse the horoscope only through the important of the 'Lagna' Lord'. 'Lagna's Rashi and Nakshatra represents the Soul of an individual person while the 'Lagna' Lord represents the 'Ruler of the Horoscope'.

'LAGNA'

In horoscopic prediction, the various 12 bhavas are separated by the first bhava. This sign known as the 'Udhaya 'Lagna' will be considered 'the first house of the horoscope' and the enumeration of the 'other houses' follows in sequence through the rest of the signs of the 'zodiac'.

Just as 'all the organs in the body' operate under the control of 'brain', so 'Lagna' controls the horoscope by controlling the 'Twelve Bhavas'.

'Lagna' shows true self. True Self means someone's knowledge or persistence. It shows the overall spirit of "I". 'Lagna' with benefits or aspected by functional benefits bestows great fortune in all walks of Life.

SIGNIFICATIONS OF HOUSES

'The Ascendant' is the first house (Bhava) and the other houses follow in succession from the 'North to west direction' in the 'North Indian chart' and from 'South to West' in the 'South Indian chart'.

In 'South Indian chart' signs are fixed, therefore there is no need to write the number of sign in the house as it is necessary to write the number of sign invariable in the house in the 'North Indian chart'.

The houses 1^{st} , 4^{th} , 7^{th} and 10^{th} are known as kendra (Quadrants) (angles), 1^{st} , 5^{th} and 9^{th} as Trikona (Trines), 2^{nd} , 5^{th} , 8^{th} and 11^{th} Panapharas (Succedent) and 3rd, 6th, 9th and 12th as Apoklimas (Cadent) Houses. The houses 3^{rd} , 6^{th} , 10^{th} and 11^{th} are Upachyas means houses of growth. The house 6th, 8th and 12th are treated as Dusthanas or Trik houses means indicating sorrow.

In vedic Astrology, there are more 'Lagna's such as Chandra 'Lagna' (Moon 'Lagna'), Ravi 'Lagna' (Sun 'Lagna'), Arudha 'Lagna', Paaka 'Lagna', Karakamsa 'Lagna', Ghati 'Lagna', Hora 'Lagna', Graha 'Lagna's.

Ravi 'Lagna' (Sun 'Lagna')

'Ravi 'Lagna' means sun taken as a reference, we can find houses from sun. Because 'Sun' is the significator of soul, these houses show things from the perspective of soul. For things related to physical vitality also, Sun is an important reference.

In present situation, all vedic Astrologers are monitoring Lagnam, Chandra Lagnam and Ravi Lagnam for their horoscopic predictions.

Chandra 'Lagna' (Moon 'Lagna')

'Chandra 'Lagna' means Moon taken as a reference. We can find houses from 'moon'. Houses counted from 'Moon' are useful in looking at things from the point of view of 'mind'. When we judge how a person's ambitious, career and the role of mind is paramount. So Chandra 'Lagna' should not be ignored.

Arudha 'Lagna'

It also shows the status of a native. A planet in the 10th house from 'Lagna' may give some important 'developments in one's profession' and from 'Chandra 'Lagna' may give some important 'mental activity in 'one's profession' and from 'Arudha 'Lagna' may give some important developments in one's 'professional status'.

Paaka 'Lagna'

'Paaka 'Lagna' is important when analyzing the natal chart, dasas and transists. 'Paaka 'Lagna' is nothing but 'Lagna' Lord taken as a reference. ''Lagna' Lord' represents the physical self of a native. Saturn's transit over the rasi containing one's 'Paaka 'Lagna' may leave one feeling sick all the time and attack the physical vitality.

Karakamsa 'Lagna'

'Atma Karaka' stands for the soul of the person and an important reference point in a 'Navamsa Chart'. Navamsa Chart throws light on the inner self and the rasi occupied by 'atma Karata' in it is called 'Karakamsa'. Propitiation of the deities corresponding to the strongest planet in the 12th house in navamsa from Karakamsa 'Lagna' can take one's soul towards moksha.

Ghati 'Lagna'

'Ghati 'Lagna' (GL)' shows self from the point of view of power, authority and fame. When we analyze promotions in career or political power of politicians, this reference is very important.

Hora 'Lagna'

'Hora 'Lagna' (HL)' shows self from the point of view of wealth. This reference is important when analyzing one's wealth.

Graha 'Lagna's

For each house, a planet works as the natural significator. To see matters signified by a house, we can take the relevant planet as the reference. The list of houses that can be seen from each planet is given in Table.

We can find a house with respect to the 'Naisargika Karaka' (Natural significator) who signifier the matter shown by a house.

For example, Venus signifies vehicles. D-16, in the chart that shows vehicles and pleasures. So the 4th from Venus in D-16 can show one's happiness from vehicles and other 'Luxuries'.

Importance of 'Lagna' (Ascendant) and 'Lagna' Lord

'Lagna', 'Moon' and 'the Sun' are the horoscope becomes 'powerful' and person is 'renowned', gets 'well recognized' and 'achieve international fame'.

'Phala Deepika' is also of the view that strength of a horoscope depends to a great extent on' the strength of 'Lagna', 'Sun' and 'Moon'.

According to 'Phala Deepika' if 'Lord of 'Lagna' is strong the native becomes famous, will be happy and Prosperous and 'Lagna' Lord is exalted person will be a king.

According to 'Jatak Parijat', if the rising sign is accepted by its own Lord, one will be master of riches, be a genius and would bring good name to his family.

'Vargottam' 'Lagna' adds additional strength.

'Parasara' says that, if 'Lagna' Lord is well placed and is placed in 'Kendras' or Trikona the native will enjoy good health.

'Leaders, talented, honorable and self-aware people' are known for their 'Lakkinam'.

The yoga, generosity, success and emphasis on prestige over money, as experienced by the horoscope are the Laknam – strengthened status system. The same is said by 'Parasharar' in 'Parashara Hora Sastra'.

That is to say (1) The Lord of the target (2) Stand in the Bhava of the target and horoscope says that (3) The person will have good health 4) Good intelligence (5) Good wit (6) and two wives.

Yogas of the 'Lagna' house

Chamara Yoga

Ascendant combining with strong benefic and Lord of 'Lagna' exalted or in its own sign in Kendra or Trikona.

Result

Rich, Famous, Long-lived and King.

Parijat Yoga

Second depositor of 'Lagna' Lord / Navamsa 'Lagna' in Kendra, Trine, own houses or exalted. Then this yoga is formed.

Result

Native born in this yoga will be enjoying all the fortunes, will be king-like, will be humble at the same time strong hearted.

Raja Yoga is felt during the second part of one's life and at a slow pace but will be steady and stable.

Malaviga Yoga

This is formed when Venus is in Kendra from 'Lagna' or Chandra 'Lagna', in its own sign or it exalted.

Artistic, Handsome, Wealth good physical strength, well educated beautiful Wife, good children.

'Lagna' Adhi Yoga

When planets are placed in the 6th, 7th and 8th houses from the 'Lagna' or the Ascendent or the moon, it forms the 'Lagna' Adhi Yoga and Chandra Adhi Yoga.

Result

A native with this yoga will be very influential, healthy and wealthy. He will possess no fear, disease or enemy.

If there in one planet is full strength in any one of these signs, that person becomes a leader. If there are two, he will be a minister and If there are three he will occupy an eminent station in life.

Parvata Yoga

According to 'Phala Deepika' 'Lagna' Lord in Kendra, Trikona exalted or in its own sign.

According to 'Jatak Parijat' this yoga is formed in two ways.

Benefits in angles: 8 and 12 free : one planet in a strengthens this yoga.

Ninth Bhava

Those who excel in worldly life and spiritual life Majestic. According to 'Parasara' he will be fortunate, dear to the people, devotee of 'Lord Vishnu' (means religious), skillful, eloquent speaker and will have wife, sons and wealth.

Tenth Bhava

Self is in the house of 'Karma'. Has professional success and can be a 'Research Scholar'. Is religious, god fearing and charitable. Is also rich famous and achieves high rank.

Eleventh Bhava

The horoscope will always be profitable in anything. Involved in art, music, romance etc. Elder brother helps, prosperity, gains in business. He will have wealth moves in a high society and has vehicles.

Twelth Bhava

The horoscope wants to spend time outside the home. Twelth is the house of loss. Health may not be good, but since 12^{th} is 'Moksha Sthan' also it may give a spiritual bent of mind. Visits holy places, gives money in charity.

If the 3rd Lord is in Lakkinam

If the 5th Lord is in Lakkinam

If the 6th Lord is in Lakkinam

If the 10th house be conjoined with a benefic and the Lord of 10th with full strength be posited in a Kendra or Trikona, identical with his own sign, the native will be fortunate like a king, will be long lived and widely renowned and will perform virtuous actions.

If the 11th Lord is in Lakkinam

Predict the acquisition or gain of articles connected with the lakkinam which is conjoined with the lord of the 11^{th} , the 2^{nd} house in which the Lord of the

 11^{th} be posited and 3^{rd} houses Lords of which occupy the 11^{th} .

If the 12th Lord is in Lakkinam

Predict loss of the articles or significations connected with the lakkinam which occupies the 12^{th} house and the 2^{nd} house in which the Lord of the 12^{th} be posited.

PLANETS IN THE 'LAGNA' BHAVAM

The benefic which are Jupiter, Venus, Mercury, Waxing Moon are good in Kendras or Trikona.

Sun

A good Sun not owning 5th, 8th, 12th and owning a Kendra or Trikona placed in laknam is a great source of strength. It gives a strong moral nature, ambition, love of power and good health.

Weak Sun makes one egotist, fond of flattery false pride, vain glorious, fevers.

Moon

A good Moon The native becomes fanciful and romantic, a moderate eater. Makes one kind, human, sympathetic extremely generous, emotional. One is fond of travel, imaginative and exposed to public life.

Weak Moon makes one unstable, unreliable, shifty wandering, moody and without aim.

Mars

A strong Mars gives courage, initiative, daring, warmth of feeling and truthfulness. The native will posses practical ability and love of liberty and independence. He might have scars on the face. He has drive and courage.


Brief of Natal Chart
